Part 1 SPEAK Live with Intent **OUT!**

In part 1, clients will work **one-on-one** with their therapist on speech, voice, and cognitive exercises.
*Meets twice-weekly for 50 minutes for 6 weeks.



Part 2 The **LOUD** Crowd

In part 2, clients transition to a maintenance **group** therapy setting.
*Meets once a week on Mondays for 50 minute sessions.
