Why do we need you?

A better understanding of how your brain controls movement will help us evaluate and develop better rehabilitation for individuals with Parkinson's disease

Who are we looking for?

We are looking for patients with Parkinson's disease and healthy individuals older than 22 years old.

What will we do?

We will measure your brain function, using non-invasive brain stimulation, called Transcranial Magnetic Stimulation (TMS) while you perform a motor task

How long will it take?

2.5 to 4 hours
